



Scot Schwandt

Since January 2007, Scot Schwandt has been the executive director of the Wisconsin Asphalt Pavement Association, a nonprofit organization with some 80 members that represents Wisconsin's asphalt industry. Schwandt is responsible for all of WAPA's administrative operations, including management of the budget, membership, conferences, communications and technical programs. Schwandt serves as WAPA's liaison with a broad range of stakeholders, such as government agencies, the transportation industry, asphalt pavement customers and the news media.

Serving in the dual role as WAPA's director of engineering, a position he has held since 2003, Schwandt provides technical guidance and expertise on all areas of asphalt pavements, from design and construction to maintenance and management. He travels across the state and assists WAPA members and their customer with specifications, designs and other needs. In this role, he also participates on Wisconsin DOT's technical panels on research and implementation related to asphalt pavements.

Prior to joining WAPA, Schwandt worked for WisDOT for 14 years. He served first as a highway bridge design engineer for the agency's bridge office and a highway construction project engineer for the Madison regional office. During his final 10 years at WisDOT, Schwandt was a pavement structural design and management engineer for the Bureau of Technical Services. In that time he developed and implemented standard design procedures for asphalt and concrete pavements, life cycle cost analysis software, and pavement specifications and performance models.

Schwandt is a registered professional engineer in the state of Wisconsin. He is also an active member of a number of national industry associations, including the Association of Asphalt Paving Technologists, the Association of Modified Asphalt Producers, the Asphalt Pavement Alliance and the American Society of Civil Engineers among others.

Schwandt received his Bachelor's of Science degree in civil and environmental engineering from the University of Wisconsin–Madison, working as a co-op student at WisDOT while an undergraduate. He is currently a Ph.D. candidate at UW–Madison in civil engineering with a minor in engineering mechanics. Schwandt continues his profession development through technical and training courses offered by the Asphalt Institute, the National Center for Asphalt Technology and Abatech.

An avid college basketball fan and home construction project enthusiast, Scot lives near Madison with his wife Melissa and their son Derek.
